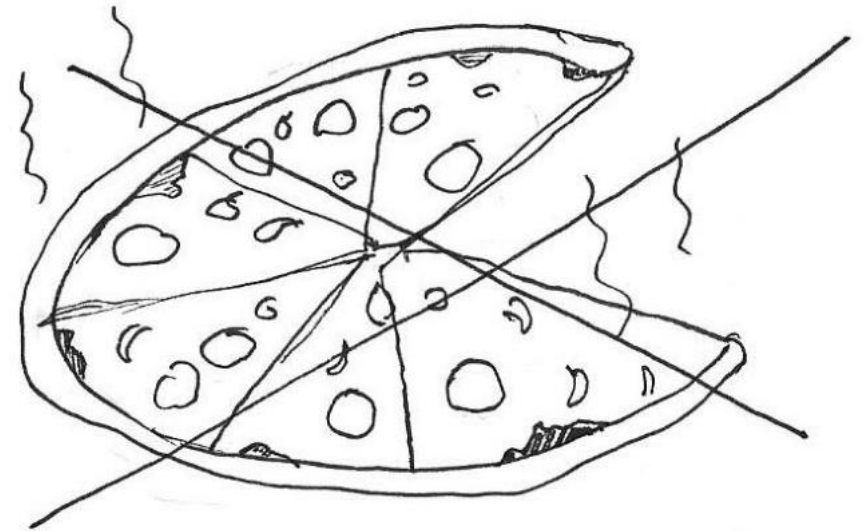
"Hmmm.... No," said Hillel.

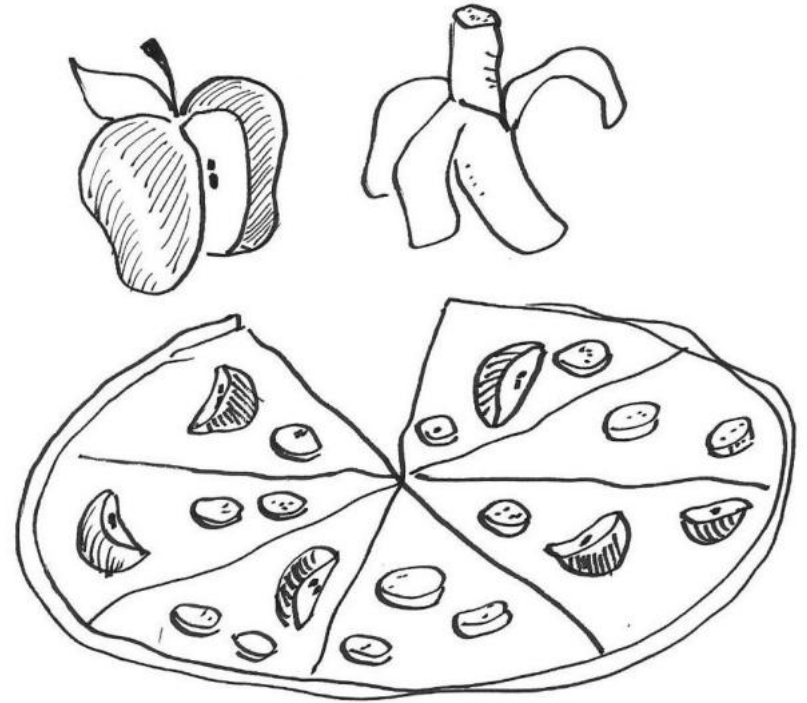
